

## ANAMNESIS - information

After publication of seven issues of *Anamnesis* (1994-1996) – Bulletin of the Polish Episcopal Commission for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments which was designed for the Polish Bishops – a new edition of *Anamnesis* is being started which is addressed to people responsible for liturgy and liturgical pastoral care in the Church in Poland, anxious for more intense renewal of the Church by more conscious, active and deepened participation of all the Christians in the Liturgy. The editorial design is to create a meeting forum for the two directions of the liturgical renewal: the one “from above” (institutional) and one “from below”.

The broad range of responsibilities entrusted to the Commission after the reform of the Polish Episcopal Conference on April 23 rd, 1996 – among others liturgical formation of the clergy and the lay, homiletic programmes, correctness of the liturgy celebrated and of liturgical texts, liturgical music and art, translations of rites and of instructions of the Apostolic See – all this calls for instituting a Liturgical Pastoral Centre for the Conference of the Polish Episcopate. This should be a body of specialists working on numerous issues, as mentioned above. Before this may become realized, president of the Commission for Divine Worship and editor of *Anamnesis* in one person would like this periodical to become such a centre, i. e., a place of encounter and cooperation of all Polish liturgists, theologians, priests and lay people, all who serve God Present in the Liturgy – the “Fount and Summit” of the Church life.

May the movement of liturgical renewal be constantly renewed, for it is the very movement that is Catholic par excellence.
